Sketchbook, $9 \times 12$ - if you are using something that accepts water media like Bee Paper Super Deluxe, that will be helpful.
Paint: Please purchase heavy body professional paint if at all possible.

$120 z$ tubes of Ultramarine Blue
Colors may be substituted if necessary but please stay as close to pure primary colors as you can.
Painting brushes _ _if you still have the brushes from the art kit those should be fine.
If those brushes are worn you may need to purchase additional brushes.
Palette: Palette Paper $9 \times 12$ is a good size ( 50 sheet pad). I recommend Grey Matters brand.
Thin Canvas Boards or similar surfaces for creating paintings on. Sizes can remain small to medium, for example $8 \times 10,9 \times 12,11 \times 14$. You may paint larger than these sizes if you wish.
Stretched Canvases are fine too but will take up more space.
Palette Knife, Diamond Shape, bent handle to keep hand out of your paint
2 Water Cups - _large yogurt cups work well. One for dirty water, one for clean.
Paper Towels
P_a_i_n_t_e_r_'s__T_a_p_e__
X-acto Knife (you likely have this already from your initial kit)
Additional colors may be desired and may be necessary beyond the midterm, but we will be working with the primary colors + black and white for the first 7 weeks. Students may need to purchase additional colors depending on how the painting process uses up the materials.
